Würth Finance International equips German, Dutch and Swiss shops with CCV POS solution acCEPT

Würth companies in Germany, the Netherlands and Switzerland have been equipped with 550 CCV payment terminals by Würth Finance International B.V. 520 CCV Base for brick-and-mortar stores and 30 CCV Mobile Premium for mobile shops and museums of the Würth Group have been rolled out together with the acCEPT central terminal server software.

In total, all terminals handle an annual transaction volume of more than EUR 10 million. Across borders, the project is based on the acCEPT server solution by CCV, including the girocard network in Germany and the ep2 protocol in Switzerland.

The virtual acCEPT solution transfers the terminal's intelligence to external servers, which is an enormous advantage in terms of maintenance, analysis and updates, as these can be managed centrally. Furthermore, CCV implemented a series of individual services in the payment software for Würth, including e.g. the usage of reference numbers, a notification service and the Würth receipt logo.

"Being the in-house bank and treasury center of the Würth Group, we have looked for a central payment terminal control system with a real-time flow of information and we are very satisfied with CCV Group's acCEPT system.
